

Oktoberfest Guidelines

Ticket Sales:

Tickets will be sold through the website and through the MRM Members. The tickets have perforated stubs on them, one for the buyer and one for the seller. The seller must fill out their portion of the stub and save them for submitting their final sales. Cash and or Checks (written out to the Muddy River Mashers) can be submitted to Randi at any time, but must be all submitted by October 2nd.

To make sure we sell all of our available tickets, a simple form has been set up to fill out to let us know how many you have on hand. Be sure to only sell tickets to persons 21 and older. Anyone underage that tries to attend the event will be turned away without a refund.

Homebrew Donation:

By donating a full batch of homebrew the brewer and their spouse gets into the Oktoberfest for free. The batch must be near full size (we know some sampling must go on for quality control.)

The person donating the beer is automatically a volunteer to the event if they can attend. Volunteers will do tasks such as serving, grilling, and greeting.

Volunteering:

Being that this event is a club fundraiser, and that the club does not have any dues or fees, members must either volunteer or donate a brew to attend without a ticket purchase. All brewers donating a beer will be the *first* taken on as volunteers. By doing this we hope to be able to showcase the individual brewer at this years event. If we find we are short-handed by the end of August, we will ask for volunteers.

Spouses:

If you've donated a beer your spouse is covered as long as you've filled out the donation [form](#) above (they'll be on the admission list). If you did not donate a beer and your spouse would like to attend they'll have to purchase a ticket.

Children:

We kindly ask that you do not bring anyone under age to this event. With the live brewing demonstration and quantity of alcohol available, we do not feel this event is suitable for children.
